Family Life Education (FLE)

K-12 Instructional Program

Adheres to state guidelines and recommendations

Includes two units of instruction at the Elementary level

- Emotional and Social Health (ESH) – Grades K-6
 - Modified lessons for students with low incidence disabilities are available
- Human Growth and Development (HGD)-Grades 4-6
 - Modified lessons for students with low incidence disabilities are available

Parents may opt their child out of any or all lessons in Emotional and Social Health and Human Growth and Development units of instruction.

Parent Access to FLE Program Materials

1. Online in Schoology

2. Lessons and media

- Lessons used for students who are opted out of FLE instruction
- Parents/Guardians will have to access through their Schoology account (same login as Parent SIS)

3. School libraries

- Lessons, media, and print materials during regular school hours (please schedule with librarian)

4. Fairfax County Regional Library in the City of Fairfax

- Lessons available; site does not have media nor print materials

How to access in Schoology

1. Log into Schoology using your parent login credentials
2. Navigate to the Kent Gardens All Parents course
3. On the materials tab, scroll down to the Parent Preview FLE instruction folder
4. Select the grade level you want to preview. Links for lessons and media are embedded

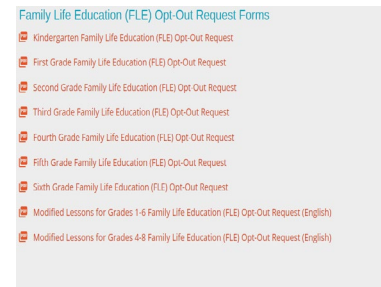
